

## Care of solid wood worktops and furniture elements

All solid wood tops and furniture pieces are protected and ready to use. The type of materials and cleaning agents we use for care is of extreme importance. It is advisable to use soft cloths and cleaners with as little chemical content as possible.

### How to clean and care for solid wood worktops and elements

- Do not use sharp sponges or other scratching objects or agents.
- Do not use dishwashing liquid, glass cleaner or any other synthetic cleaning agents (CAUTION! all such liquids may destroy the protective coating of countertops and furniture elements).
- Try to wipe wet stains as soon as possible. It is best to use a soft cloth for this.
- For daily care of wooden worktops and furniture elements, it is sufficient to clean or vacuum the surface and wipe it wet with a well wrung out, absorbent material. Water should not be left on the surface, it should always be wiped dry.

### Maintenance / Care

- The most vulnerable areas of worktops and furniture elements that are most susceptible to abrasion or drying out, e.g. around a washbasin, should be maintained more frequently.
- Depending on the intensity of use of the wooden surfaces, maintenance should be carried out **at least once a year** before abrasions appear.
- Maintenance should be carried out with a wood care oil such as Heidelberger 811-0001.
- If scratches occur, sand the surface lightly with a fleece or fine sandpaper in the direction of the grain of the wood. Then remove the dust with a soft cloth. If there are no scratches, it is sufficient to apply Heidelberger 811- 0001 parallel to the grain of the wood with a soft and dry cloth in order to obtain a protective coating, and then leave it to dry completely.
- After care is completed, the used cloth should be immediately immersed in water and rinsed, then dried or placed and left in a container of water to prevent the risk of spontaneous combustion.
- The product and materials soaked in conservative oil are subject to the risk of flammability.

ATTENTION! The procedure for the care/maintenance of wood can be found on the packaging - wood care oil, which is placed by the manufacturer, and always follow and adhere to the guidelines indicated therein.
